OVERVIEW

Balboa Academy is a private, co-educational day school founded in 1999 to provide students (PK 3 - 12) with a US standards-based curriculum in which English is the language of instruction. BA is accredited by Cognia/AdvancED and the Panamanian Ministry of Education (MEDUCA). The school year begins in August and ends in June and this year's enrollment was 881. The student body is international consisting of 41% Panamanian, 15% U.S., and 44% from other countries. There are a total of 31 nationalities at Balboa Academy.

PROFESSIONAL MEMBERSHIP

Balboa Academy is a member of International Association of College Admissions Counseling, American School Counselor Association, The National Honor Society, The National English Honor Society, and the Association of American Schools in Central American.

HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT BODY

Currently, there are 311 students enrolled in high school, grades 9-12. The Senior class number is 66, the Junior class 85, the Sophomore class 84, and the Freshman class 75. All students graduate with the U.S. High School diploma and a Bachiller en Ciencias y Letras from Panama. Ninety-nine percent (99%) of graduates go on to university studies.

CURRICULUM

Courses at Balboa Academy are college preparatory. We currently offer 19 Advanced Placement courses and 4 PreAP courses. The maximum enrollment depends on the schedule and acceptance by the AP teacher. AP subjects include Art History, Biology, Calculus AB, Comparative Government, Computer Science Principles, English Language, English Literature, Environmental Science, Human Geography, Physics 1, Psychology, Seminar, Research, Spanish Language, Spanish Literature, Statistics, Studio Art 2D, Studio Art Drawing, and World History.


AP CAPSTONE DIPLOMA

The AP Capstone Diploma allows students to engage in the rigorous development of inquiry, research, collaboration, and writing skills. It's meant to complement the in-depth, subject-specific rigor of AP courses and exams. To earn the AP Capstone Diploma students must successfully complete at least 4 AP subjects in addition to passing the AP Seminar and AP Research courses.

SERVICE AND LEADERSHIP

Balboa Academy empowers students to become citizens of leadership and service through community service. Students need 80 hours of community service to graduate. Our high school student council (DRACO) plans and implements all activities in the school. Balboa Academy has over 30 student founded / lead clubs.


AP HIGHLIGHTS
