Mission Statement

The mission of Crossroads Christian Academy (CCA) is to assist the family and the Church by developing students academically, spiritually, and socially under the leadership of Jesus Christ, and to support and encourage the spiritual and professional growth of the faculty and staff.

School History

CCA was founded in 1997 as a $K3 - 8^{th}$ grade program in the Republic of Panama. In 1999, 9^{th} - 12^{th} grades were added and the first class of three seniors graduated in 2000. CCA operates under a Board of Directors composed of Biblical Christians, committed to serving the Lord, CCA staff and students. The school is a ministry of Crossroads Bible Church (CBC - www.cbcpanama.org), an interdenominational evangelical church that ministers to both the English and Spanish-speaking communities of Panama, within the CBC facilities.

Community

CCA serves the international and Panamanian communities. The student body at CCA currently consists of 194 students, representing over 18 nationalities. Approximately half of our students are Panamanian, and the other half are comprised of U.S. citizens and students with other nationalities whose families are temporarily in Panama from a variety of countries for diplomacy, banking, humanitarian work, import/export and tourism. The student body is comprised of citizens from countries such as Canada, China, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, India, Indonesia, Italy, Mexico, Netherlands, Nicaragua, South Korea, Spain, United States and Venezuela.

Faculty

The CCA faculty is comprised of 31 full-time teachers and administrators and 4 part-time members. Approximately 47% are US citizens and the rest are Panamanian or from other countries. Approximate 34% of our faculty hold advanced degrees. Each elementary grade has one teacher (with teacher aides in larger classes). The secondary faculty consists of trained teachers in English/Literature, Mathematics, Social Studies, Science, Foreign Language, and Bible. Other trained teachers provide instruction in Physical Education, Art, Music, and Technology. Our teacher supervision structure consists of an Elementary Principal and Secondary Principal. We have other coordinators as well, including Admissions/Registrar Coordinator, Technology Coordinator, Spanish Coordinator, Spiritual Life Coordinator, College Counselor, Health Services Personnel, and Librarian.
