






Who We Are

Innovation & Entrepreneurship Certificate Program (IEC)

Developed in partnership with the University of Delaware and the University of Iowa, the Innovation and Entrepreneurship Certificate (IEC) is a two year long program that offers personalized learning experiences to students who have a passion to develop a social entrepreneurial mindset and become innovators and changemakers. Eligible IEC students will have the opportunity to earn up to 6 college credits.

The MEDUCA Diploma (Panama Official Diploma)

Students who elect to take the MEDUCA Diploma must fulfill certain national requirements, including Biology, Physics, Chemistry, Math (4 years), Spanish (4 years), Philosophy, Panamanian Studies, and 80 hours of community service.
